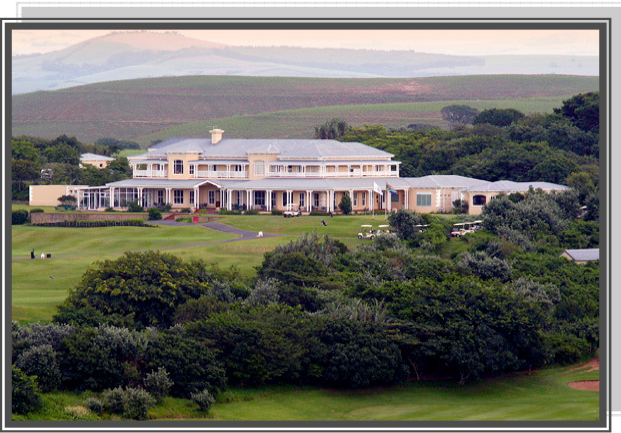


GENERATOR AT THE LODGE
