**THE TENNIS COURT WILL BE OUT OF BOUNDS DURING THIS PERIOD.**



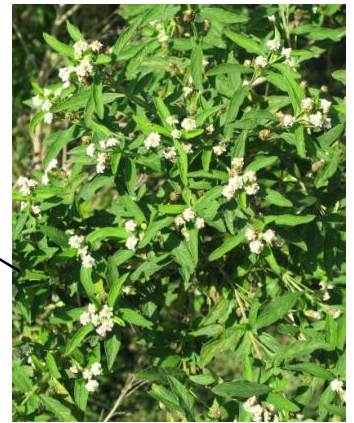

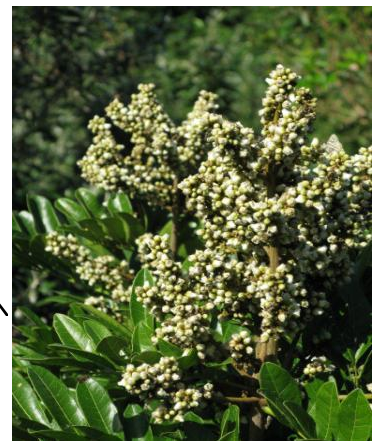

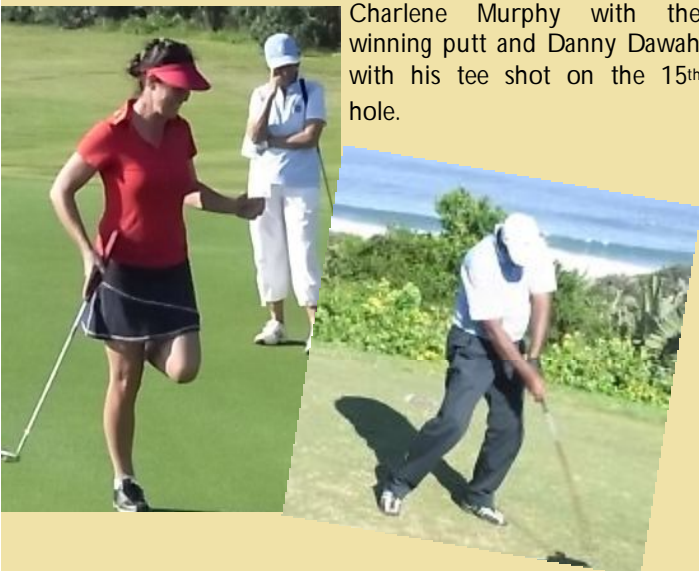
## COMPETITION RESULTS
