## Dear Homeowners

### Security Incident

As reported earlier, the SAPS with the assistance of the private investigator we've appointed and IPSS identified two of the suspects and we hope arrests will be made soon. The domestic servant who was working in the house was taken for a polygraph test which she unfortunately failed indicating the possibility that she provided some information about the residents to the culprits. Our private investigator is dealing with this and the individual together with the results of the polygraph was handed over to the police.

In the meantime, homeowners will note that construction of the concrete plinth on our sea facing boundary, which was scheduled to commence after the Easter holiday, will commence this week. The implementation of the plinth was scheduled over a period of three years of which this is the final phase. Our number one priority at this stage is to do everything in our power to ensure that the perpetrators are arrested and charged. We have a competent team of security personnel working on this matter.

### Lodge

On Saturday, Prince's Grant will host a wedding at which various cabinet ministers, MECs and other South African dignitaries will be present. For this purpose, a large marquee was erected in the Lodge parking area in front of the Conference Centre. The wedding ceremony, with limited numbers, will take place alongside the 6th dam, whereafter the reception will be hosted at the Conference Centre and marquee. The ceremony will obviously be hosted after the golf. This wedding will be a test for our new kitchen facilities and will indicate the capacity which the Lodge will be able to handle in the future.

On the estate and golf course, homeowners will note some work on the second fairway. This is necessary as a result of problems experienced with our communal soakaways and in particular the soakaway situated underneath the second fairway. We've reported earlier that the sewerage system on the estate is under severe pressure during the busy periods and this manifested itself during the busy Easter period when this particular soakaway overflowed and

"grey water" spilled into the second dam. Our estate staff will be busy at this area until a suitable solution has been found for the problem and in the meantime, we will continue to pursue the option of small sewerage package plants as an alternative to soakaways.

As the chairman reported earlier, our Marketing Manager, Mr Mike McNamara, has joined Prince's Grant and is currently busy at the Tourism Indaba that is being held in Durban. We have commenced with the appointment of a Lodge Manager and we will report on this in due course.
