Dear Homeowners

Festive Greetings to all Prince's Grant Homeowners. At the start of the new year we wish every homeowner the very best for 2011.

The December holidays at Prince's Grant was no doubt the busiest yet and according to most, it was a memorable and enjoyable experience. On Christmas Eve our security reported that 212 of the 264 completed houses at Prince's Grant were occupied. The new beach bar was well received by homeowners and on 21st December, an estimated 300 people enjoyed the ambience of a "bon fire on the beach". Despite the soft rain, the new year was welcomed by more than 100 people on the beach with again a big "bon fire" and some fireworks.



From 16 December to 31 December Vani and her "Estate" team organized thirteen special events for homeowners and their guests excluding a daily "kiddies" program that ran from the 16th to the 24th. We wish to thank every homeowner who participated in making these events a success and wish to specifically mention Eunice Grobler for her incredible support and initiative.

Kim and her team in the Proshop organized twelve different golf competitions between the 16th December



and the 1st January, including a juniors "4-hole competition" which we hope will grow from strength to strength. The golf course was busy with an average of 160 rounds per day for the period 15th December to 3rd January, with Wednesday the 29th December, a new record for any single day of 215 rounds.

Our Lodge was equally busy with many days almost impossible to cope with the number of people who came to eat. Excluding our themed buffets such as Christmas, New Year, etc. our kitchen staff served on average 437 meals per day for the period 15-31 December. We apologise to homeowners and their guests who had to wait to get their meal and/ or a seat. The daily buffet has helped with the congestion and we will add to this in future to alleviate some of the pressure in our small kitchen. From the 15th December our Lodge was 72% full and of these guests, 82% indicated the experience surpassed their expectations. This is a measurement we follow closely and strive to improve on every year.

We would like to thank all the home owners for their support through the festive season. The lodge served a total of 8424 meals during December which kept most of us very busy.

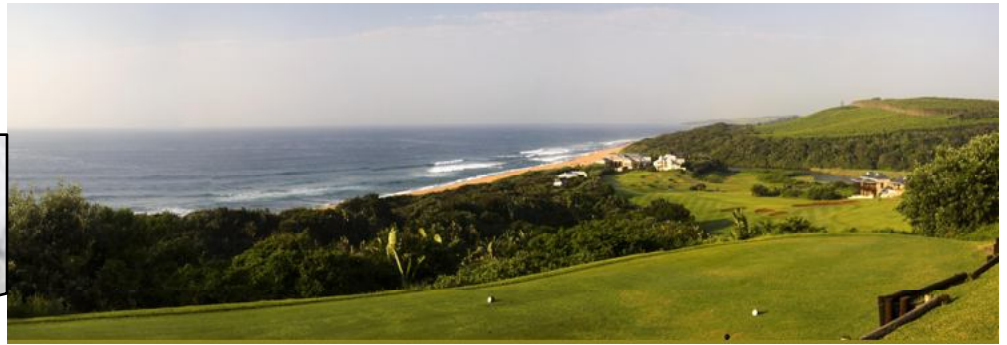
We will also feature our Curry Buffet from 6pm Friday thru Sunday - R75 per person.
