On the Estate, the majority work on the re-alignment of the 18th cart-path and the walkway between 13 and 14 has now been completed. The work around the Lodge is continuing and we await installation of a small irrigation system. Work on the new golf warm-up area, between the 7th and 9th holes, will commence soon. We are planning to build two target greens on at 100m and 150m from the tee-off area.

The concrete plinth underneath our electric fence is progressing well and we are busy with the last section alongside the 4th fairway.

On a negative note, we have experienced a couple of incidents where some of our members and their guests behaved poorly whilst under the influence of alcohol at our Lodge. Homeowners must please note that the Lodge is a family friendly venue and also caters for visitors staying at the hotel. Uncontrolled and drunken behaviour cannot be condoned or tolerated and should anyone behave in an un-social manner, we will have no option to prohibit them from using the facilities. We are possibly in the most festive period in our country's history and one can only ask that the festive moods not become a burden to others using the Lodge or any other facility on the Estate.

BUILDING COMMITTEE MEETING

The Building committee met on 23 June 2010. Plans for Lots 272, 299 and 369 were submitted for approval. Lot 272 and 299 was approved, Lot 369 was referred back to the architect. The system comes from the SAGA with a 3G card which proved to be ineffective and the Proshop will link up with an ADSL line which will allow for better connectivity. The system also has a few "teething" problems that the SAGA is currently working on and should be resolved shortly.
