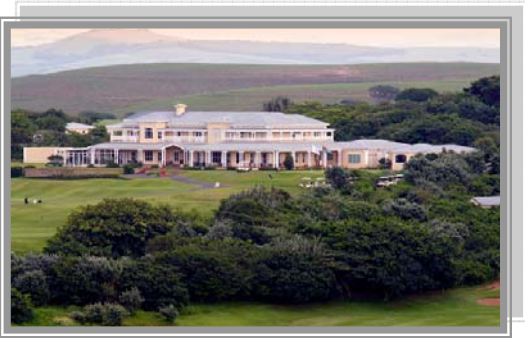

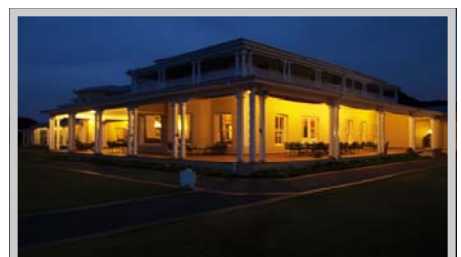
On Friday 11 June the lodge will have traditional South African dishes on special and a big screen in the pub for the opening game-S.A versus Mexico.
